All \LaTeX commands begin with a backslash. Many take arguments in curly braces afterwards and some take optional arguments in square brackets. Examples:

```
\textbf{bold text}
```

```
\begin{itemize}  
  \item[a)] list item  
  \item[z)] list item  
\end{itemize}
```

```
Some math is  $2^{32}$ .
```

This produces:

bold text

a) list item

z) list item

Some math is 2^{32} .
