

CPSC 304 Formal Specifications Checklist

- 1) (5 points) \geq 5 entities with correct primary keys and candidate keys
- 2) (5 points) \geq 5 relationships with correct cardinality and participation constraints
- 3) (5 points) correct translation of entities and relationships into tables, with correct primary keys and foreign keys
- 4) (5 points) correctly identify functional dependencies, candidate keys for all tables
- 5) (5 points) correct normalization, or at least correctly stating that tables are in 3NF or BCNF along with relevant information
- 6) (5 points) translation into SQL DDL for table creation
- 7) (5 points) correct instances of tables with \geq 5 tuples inserted
- 8) (5 points) \geq 10 functionality specifications
- 9) (5 points) \geq 1 interesting functionality specifications that requires a moderately sophisticated SQL statement to update part of the database
- 10) (5 points) \geq 1 interesting functionality specifications that requires a moderately sophisticated SQL statement to query (depending on the user's input) part of the database
- 11) (5 points) specify the platform to use
- 12) (5 points) specify the data that is to be used in the final application
- 13) (5 points) specify the division of labour
- 14) (5 points) richness of design in terms of the features it exhibits
- 15) (5 points) connection to the database and a screenshot of the selection query
