- Shrinking social networks
 - Relocation
 - Death of friends
 - Decreased social ability

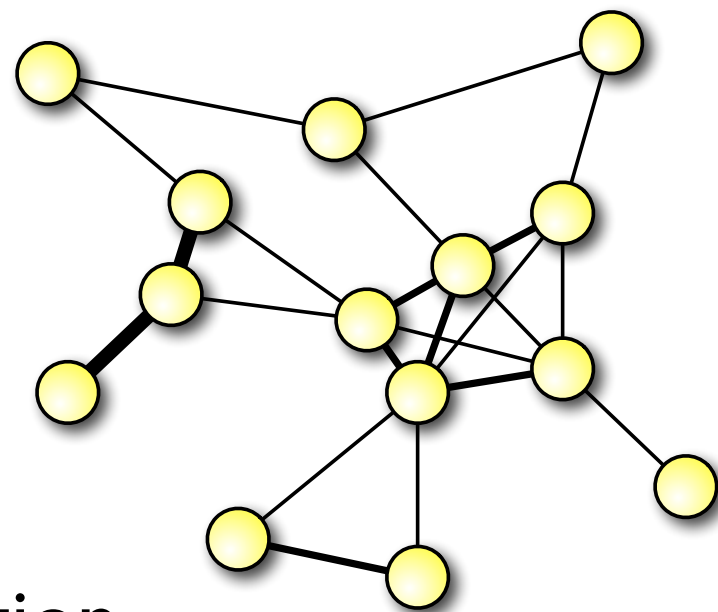
Understanding Social Networks

- Build models of elders social networks
- Identify *low social participators*
- Monitor social behavior identifying key relationships
- Build *prompting* system to encourage social interaction

Social Network Models

- Past modeling typically required extensive direction observation and surveys or questionnaires
- Recent research utilizes sensors deployed in the environment
- We focus on location-based sensors

Location-based Models



- Ekahau WiFi positioning
- Record instances of co-location
- More co-location results in strong ties in network model

Intervention Tool

- Prompt users to participate in activities
- Most effective when aligned with users social relationships or interests
- Must be very simple, but also personalized
- Machine learning techniques to infer types of prompts effective for a *given user*
