  - o a Major, Combined Major, Honours or Combined Honours specialization in Computer Science.
  - the BCS program.
  - the Computational Intelligence and Design stream of the Cognitive Systems program.
  - one of the other streams of the Cognitive Systems program, only need one additional COGS module course to graduate, and none of the non-CPSC module courses for which you have prerequisites has space.
  - the CMS SCIE specialization, are pursuing the CPSC option, and need only one additional CPSC course to complete graduation requirements.

- Seats are available in CPSC courses that will allow you to meet graduation requirements, but you'd prefer to take other courses
- You want to take a CPSC course to satisfy technical or general upper level elective requirements.
- You want to take a CPSC course to satisfy the thematic concentration requirement for the STAT major.
- You want to take a CPSC course to satisfy a requirement of a program outside the Faculty of Science where students partly design their own curriculum (for instance the Interdisciplinary Studies BA or the BASC in Integrated Engineering).
- You want to take a CPSC course to satisfy the CPSC option in the CMJ SCIE specialization, and more than one additional CPSC course is needed to complete graduation requirements.

- You want to take a CPSC course because you want to get into grad school.
- You want to take a CPSC course to help your future career plans.

Please note that the department does not guarantee that you will be registered in the requested courses. Assuming you meet the conditions stated above, we will add you to course(s) that fit your schedule, for which you have the necessary prerequisites and that will allow you to meet graduation requirements. Note that we will typically register you in courses that have the shortest waitlist or highest probability of a seat opening up.
