Alexander College has two campuses; one in Burnaby and one in downtown Vancouver, both in close proximity to SkyTrain services. Growth at the college over the past year has been extraordinary resulting in strain on existing facilities in Burnaby.

In response to this issue, college administration is now implementing a plan to move the Burnaby campus to a new location (essentially across the street from the current location) @ Kingsway and McKay. The space available for classrooms is expected to double. As well, there will be space for other improvements and features. Instructors and students are looking forward to the upgrade which is scheduled for completion in 2012.

Labs

The labs are running Windows XP with Office 2007. Software development environments are provided for Python and Java. The software is sufficient for the entry level topics taught at our courses. The IT department is working on software upgrades, likely in conjunction with the move of our Burnaby campus to the new location.
