Computing Science Enrolments (Domestic/International)

- 1.COMP 3410 (Operating Systems): capacity had to be doubled from 25 to 50 this Fall.
- 2. According to the Stable Enrolment Report for Fall 2011 issued by Karen Grigoleit (Manager, Institutional Planning & Analysis): domestic enrolments have decreased slightly from last year. There is a continued growth with International enrolments. Total enrolments have been steadily increasing since Fall 2008:
