Problem

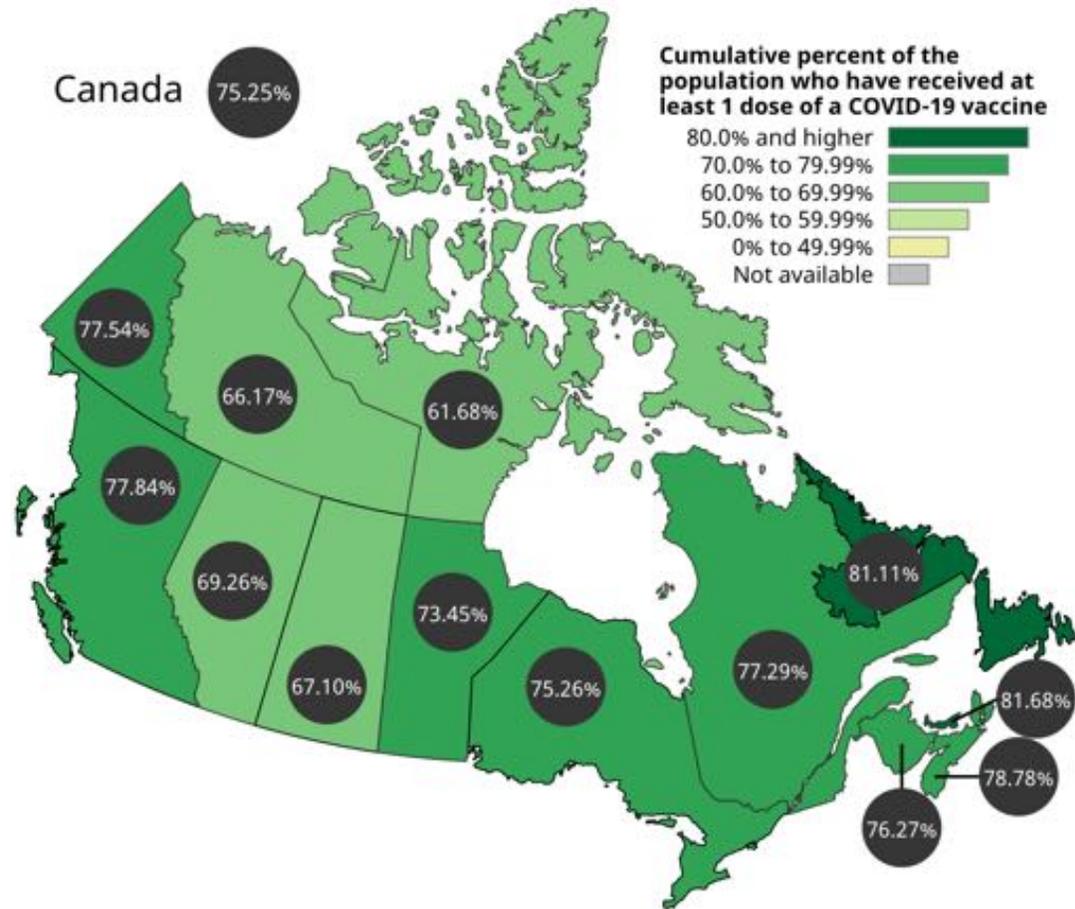
- In Canada, the COVID data is handled by each province

Vaccination rates across Canada



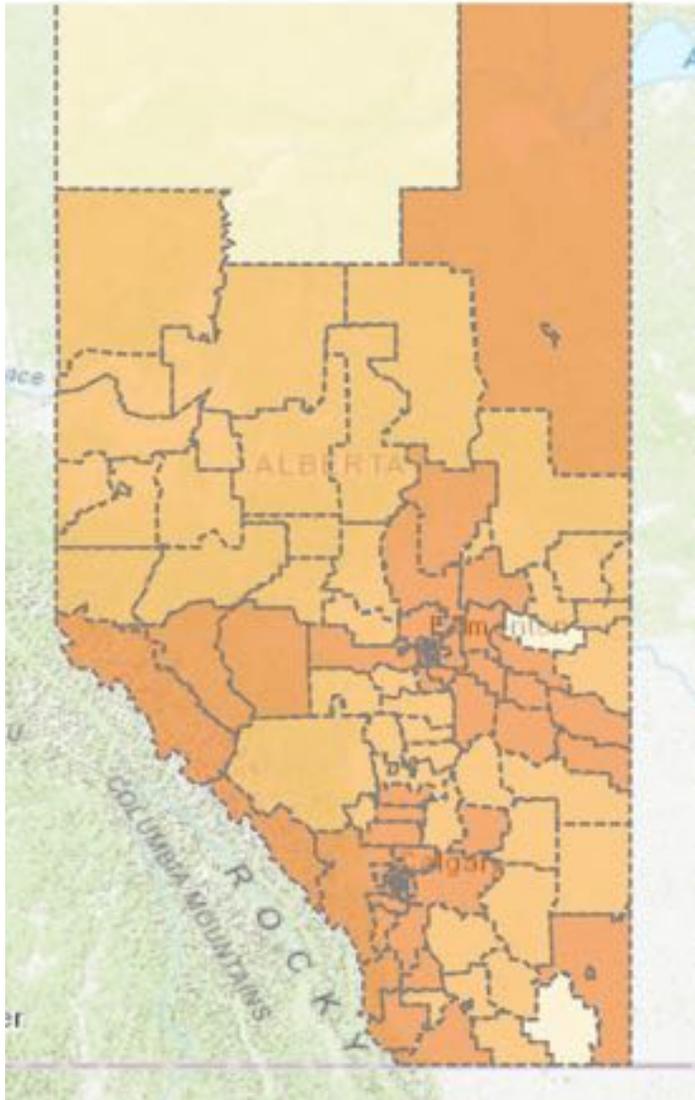
