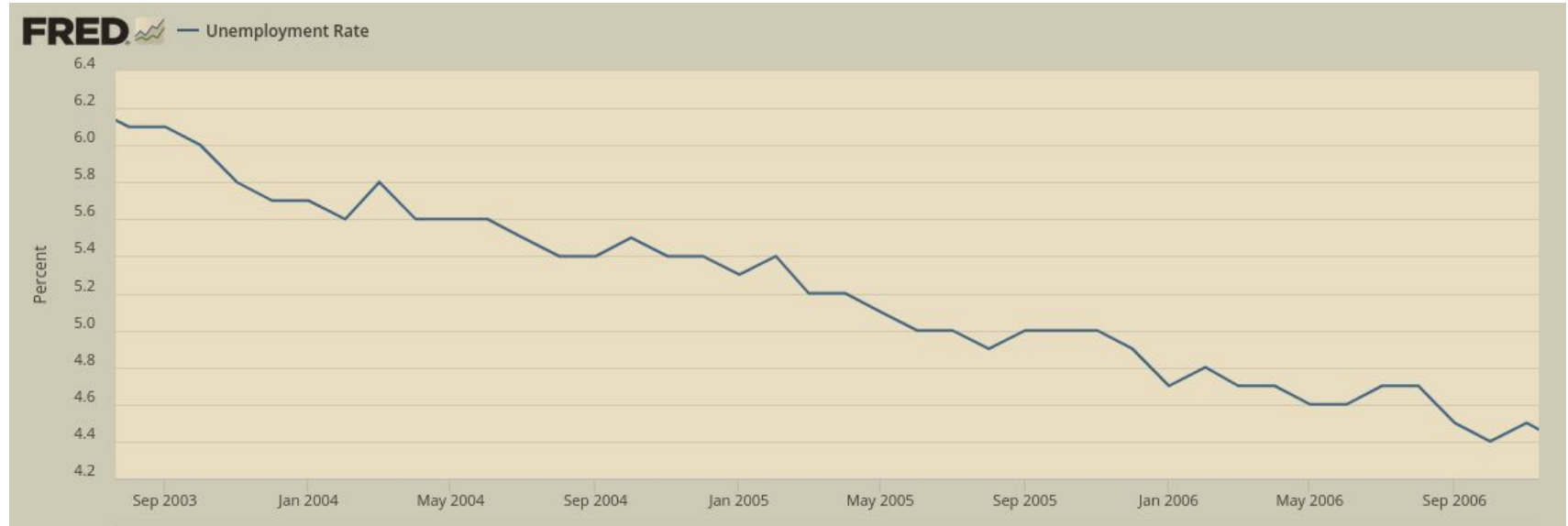

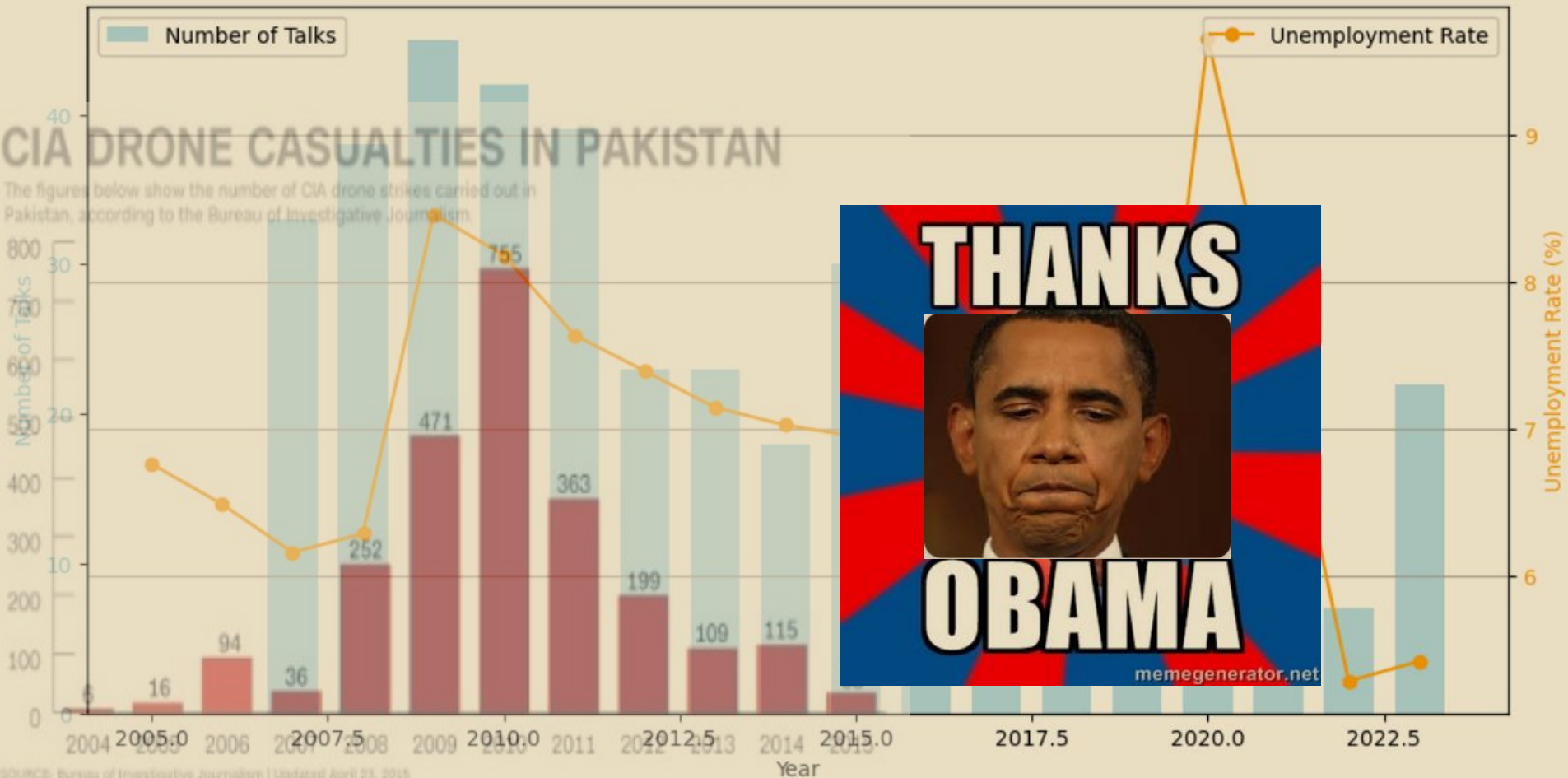

Number of Talks and Unemployment Rate Over Years

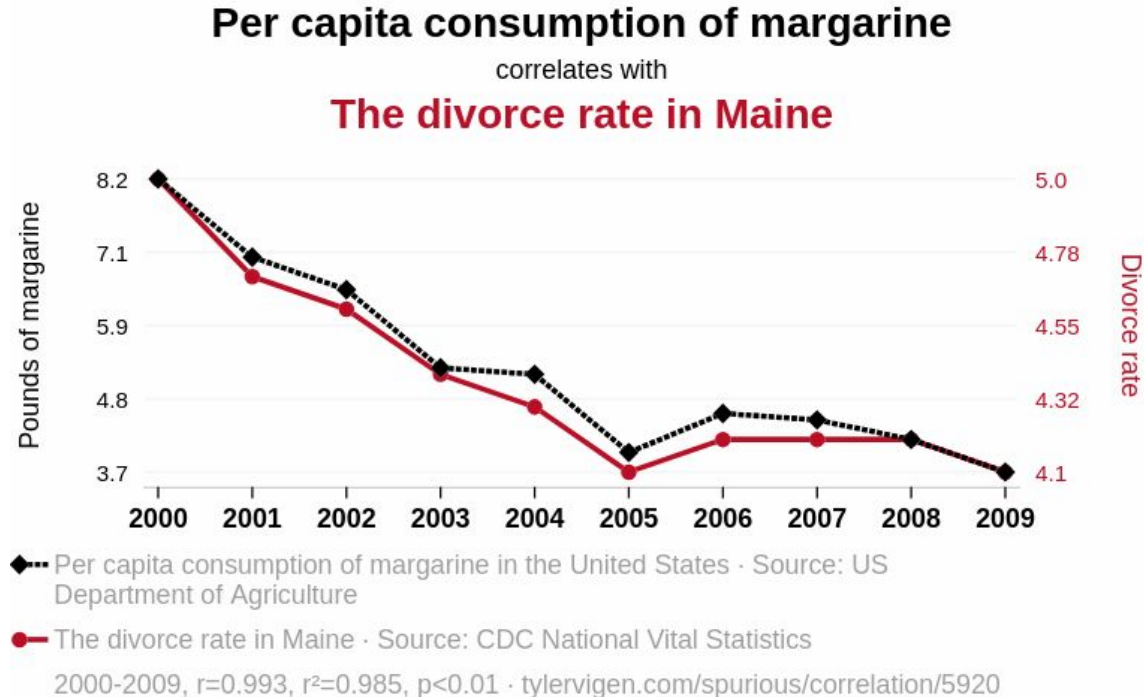
CIA DRONE CASUALTIES IN PAKISTAN

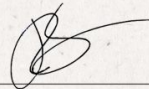

Q. What made you such a prolific UDLS speaker?

The same thing that drives many of us during a PhD program — procrastination. But more seriously: curiosity and friends. It was a nice tradition to meet up and to share what we were interested in with each other.





Q. What would you like to say to all the current and future UDLS speakers / CS grad students who look towards you as an inspiration?

Whether in UDLS, or your lab's reading groups, or knowledge sharing sessions wherever you end up working, it is a valuable professional practice to share and teach and learn with peers. I hope you all end up somewhere with this built into the culture, or are able to instill it yourself.





Q. And in what ways did it help you in your journey after you graduated?



You'll see that a couple of of my presentations were about intellectual property law. I'm now a lawyer at the Department of Justice Canada (not practicing intellectual property law). 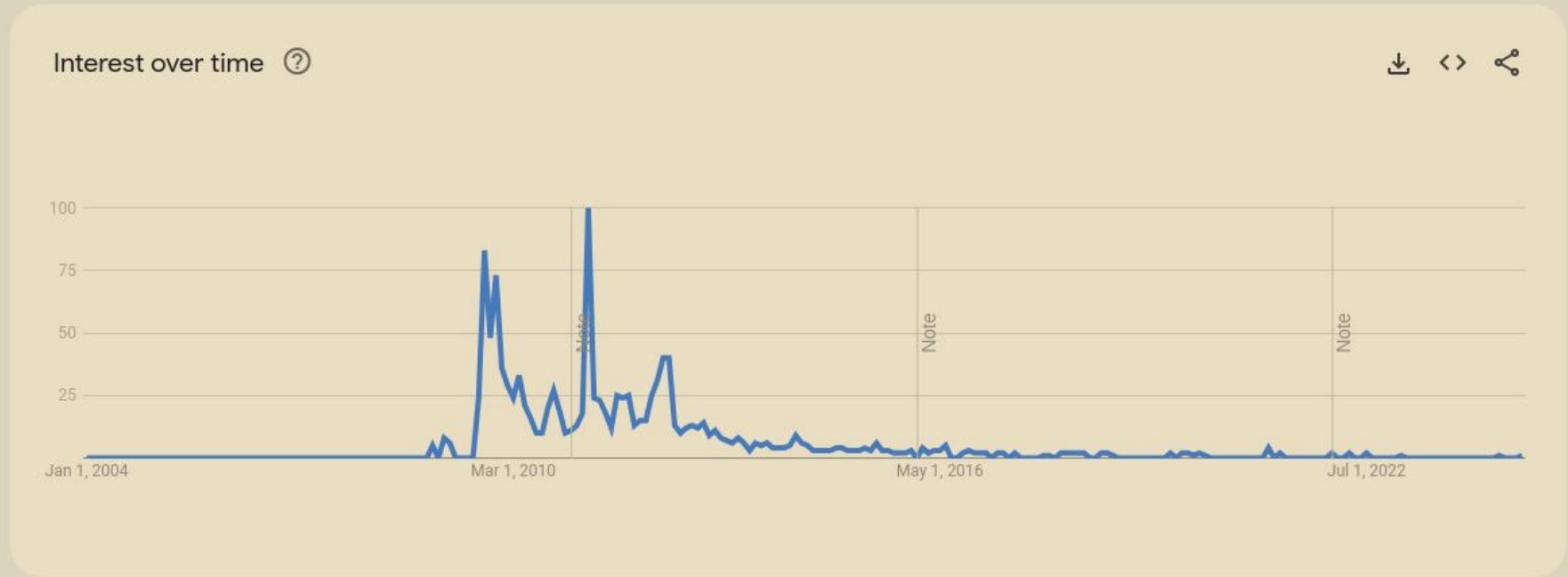

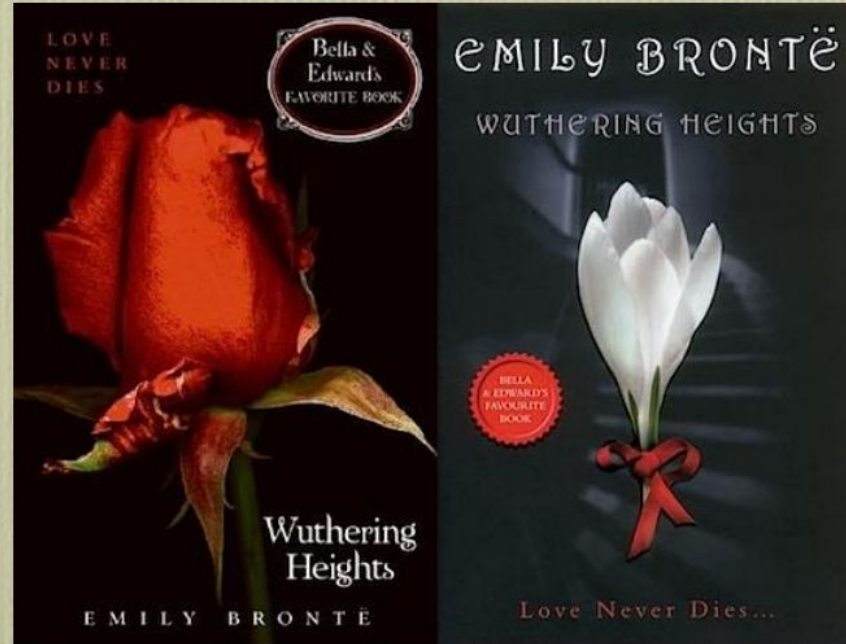

Abstract

so the answers cannot be dogmatic. However, a reasonable extrapolation from biological data and Scripture can be made about the nature of microbes in a fully mature creation. This article attempts to provide reasonable answers to when microbes were created and is meant to stimulate discussion and further research in this area.

Very little has been written in Bible commentaries or in creation literature on the subject of when microbes were created. Some have postulated that microbes were created on a single day of Creation, such as Day Three—when the plants were made. This is partially due to the “seed-like” characteristics that bacteria and fungi have—therefore classifying microbes as plants. In addition, we observe microbes (such as *Escherichia coli*) isolated in the lab and we tend to think of microbes as individual entities much like birds or fish or animals and, therefore, created on a
