



- 1858 Dom, Eiger, Nadelhorn, Piz Morteratsch, Wildstrubel
- 1859 Aletschhorn, Bietschhorn, Grand Combin, Grivola, Rimpfischhorn, Monte Leone
- 1860 Alphubel, Blüemlisalphorn, Civetta, Gran Paradiso, Grande Casse






